The second page with nested, “vertically compressed” lists using the `itemize` and `enumerate` environments.

- first line in an itemized list
- second line in an itemized list
 1. first line of numbered list
 2. second line of numbered list
- final line in itemized list[†]

For footnotes, the `footmisc` package, providing the options `perpage` and `symbol` is recommended.

* footnotes are often not a good idea for a presentation [†] ... it is therefore useful to write comments into a single footnote paragraph in order to save space

used for: vertically compressed lists with small “titles”
